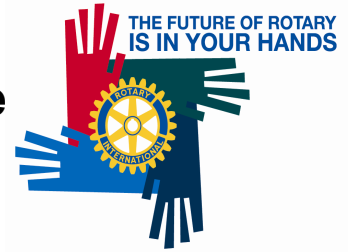

“HUMAN CHAIN” MECHANICS

1. Each Club is requested to bring a maximum of 100 human chain participants - club officers, members, families & friends. Half of the participants' t-shirt color will be **royal blue and the other half will be golden yellow (Rotary colors)**.
2. Club logos on tarpaulin will be placed at designated places, hanging on electric posts, and around the perimeter fence of the Quezon Memorial Circle, the week before to identify each club's assembly and starting point for the **Feb. 27, 2010 (Saturday)** morning's Human Chain activities.
3. In the morning, each club's participants, half wearing royal blue and half in golden yellow, are expected to be in the vicinity of the Quezon Memorial Circle between 5:00 am and 6:30 am.
4. Parking area available at the QC Hall grounds.
5. Participants will proceed to their respective club's designated place around the perimeter of the Quezon Memorial Circle before 7:00 a.m.
6. Participants will line up along the Circle, with arms locked sideways to form the human chain facing the road, around the perimeter of the Quezon Memorial Circle by 7:00 a.m.
7. At 7:00 a.m. sharp, the Rotary Hymn will be played for all to hear. At the agreed signal (sometime at the beginning of the hymn), participants alternating blue & yellow shirts will begin to walk around the perimeter of the Quezon Memorial Circle.
8. Participants can bring umbrellas, preferably blue or yellow, in case of rain, for sunshield and whatever aesthetic value it may project.
9. After the walk, all club Presidents and PEs, with their Banners, shall proceed to the Rotary Peace Monument, the venue of the Program Proper.
10. A brief program at the Rotary Peace Monument will then be conducted. After the covenant signing, 'peace' doves and balloons will be released.
11. Fellowship 'potluck' follows.
12. A Souvenir Program will be produced and published to help defray the financial requirements of the activity in lieu of a CO-HOSTING FEE. All clubs and individuals will be encouraged to solicit page AD subscriptions (with 20% commission)
13. All Club Presidents and their Secretaries will be sent E-copies of Project Concept and Mechanics for discussion during their club Meetings.
